APPLICATION SURFACE PREPARATION

Concrete substrate must be clean and sound. Water blast or chip away all marine growth, punky concrete, deteriorated wood, rust scale and any other foreign matter.

MIXING

Mix approximately 5.0 L (1.32 U.S. gal) of potable water with each 20 kg (44 lb.) bag of CPD® Aquacrete. Do not mix product with sea water. Always add water to the mixing container before adding CPD® Aquacrete powder. Mix no more than one bag at a time.

If mixing in a rotary mixer, use a small mixer with rubber tipped paddles. Small quantities of 2-8 kg (4-17 lb.) can be mixed in a bucket by hand. Thoroughly mix the product until a stiff plastic consistency is achieved. Do not mix more than one minute.



FINISHING AND CURING

Place and finish by hand. No curing protection is required for under water placement.
